

Statistics to Consider in Regards to the 13th Amendment Related to 52 Murders in Belize for the Period of January 1, 2025 through July 22, 2025

In consideration of the 13th Amendment I believe it is important to make decisions based on statistics. The following statistics cover the 52 murders that happened in Belize from the period of January 1, 2025 to July 22, 2025. The data has been compiled from hundreds of news reports and illuminated by people with knowledge of gang associations.

Briefly, 27 of the 52 victims had no gang affiliation whatsoever. Of the gang, cartel or drug related murders, 16 were gang members, 4 were family members of gang members, 4 were drug related and 1 was cartel related. So 25 of the 52 were gang or cartel or drug related.

What gangs were involved in murders?

The 16 gang members killed were from the following gangs:

Belize City: Backa Lands Crips (BLC), Boneyard Crips, Ghostown, Majestic Alley Crips, Gaza Crips, Fabers Road, Southside Crips, Mayflower, PIV Bloods, Victoria Street, 107, Taylors Alley

Cayo: RCG, Anotherworld, Unitedville, Cotton Tree

Was an SOE in effect at the time of the murder?

13 of the 25 gang/cartel/drug related murders occurred when there was no SOE

10 occurred when no SOE was possible because cabinet was not in session to declare an SOE.

1 gang member was killed and 1 cartel related murder occurred during the SOE from May 7 to June 7, 2025. Both of these bodies were dumped...one in a cemetery in Unitedville and one at a quarry on the outskirts of Belmopan

15 of the 25 gang, cartel and drug related murders occurred under Chester Williams (January 1 to April 30, 2025) and 10 occurred under Dr. Richard Rosado (May 1 to July 22, 2025)

What were the Ages of Murder Victims (all 52)

25% of the victims were ages 18 to 25, 19.2% of the victims were ages 36-40, 13.5% of the victims were ages 26-30, 11.5% of the victims were between 31-35, 9.6% were ages 46-50, 9.6% of the victims were 56-60, 5.8% were ages 41-45, 1 was over 70 and 1 was unknown age

What was the Race of Murder Victims? (all 52)

54% of victims were creole, 30% were hispanic, 6% were Mayan, 4% were Garifuna. There was 1 caucasian, 1 Guatemalan, and 1 Honduran murdered. 26.9% of murders occurred between 6 and 9pm, 17.3% occurred between 9 and midnight,

What time and days did the murders occur? (all 52)

15.4% occurred between noon and 3pm, 9.6% occurred between 6 am and 9am, 7.7% occurred between 9 am and noon, and 7.7% occurred between midnight and 3am and less than 2% occurred between 3am and 6am. Friday had 12 murders, Saturday had 10, Sunday had 9, Monday had 8, Wednesday had 6, Thursday had 4 and Tuesday had 3.

Were the victims affiliated with a gang?

16 of the 52 victims were known gang members
4 of the 52 victims were family members of gang members
4 of the 52 victims were reported to be drug related
1 of the 52 victims was most likely cartel related
1 had no gang affiliation but went to help a brother who was robbed
6 had no gang affiliation but had disputes with friends
7 had no gang affiliation but had disputes with family
4 had no gang affiliation but had disputes with business associates
2 had no gang affiliation but were related to domestic violence
6 had no gang affiliation but had unknown motives
1 had no gang affiliation and was killed while in police custody

How were they killed?

1 was in police custody and died from restraint asphyxia
1 was tortured and burned to death (most likely cartel)
1 was beaten to death (domestic violence)
6 were chopped to death (none of these were gang related)
7 were stabbed to death (none of these appear to have been gang related)
35 were shot to death. All 35 had multiple shots towards them (some of these may have been murders for hire and gang members may have been hired to do the executions for pay)
1 is unknown

Where did the murders occur?

55.8% of the murders occurred in the Belize District, 15.4% in the Cayo District, 13.5% in the Stann Creek District, 9.6% in the Toledo District, 3.8% in the Orange Walk District and less than 1% in the Corozal District.

Of the murders in the Belize District 24.1% were on the Northside, 37.9% were on the Southside for a total of 62% of the Belize District Murders being located in Belize City. The remaining Belize District Murders were as follows 17.1% of the Belize District Murders were at the Cayes with 10.3% in San Pedro, 3.4% in Caye Caulker, 3.4% at Turneffe. Additionally 6.9% of the murders were in Burrel Boom, 3.4% in Double Head Cabbage, 3.4 % in Hattievill and 3.4% in Ladyville which means that 38% of the Belize District Murders were NOT in Belize City.

7 were transported alive to a hospital but later died.
16 were killed at their homes and died before they could be transported to hospital
21 were killed at the scene and body found on the street
2 were dumped (one in a cemetery)

4 died in a vehicle
 2 were found in remote areas

The 16 gang members were shot in the following locations

6 were shot on the Northside of Belize City
 6 were shot on the Southside of Belize City
 1 in Ladyville, Belize District
 1 in Double Head Cabbage, Belize District
 1 in Unitedville, Cayo District
 1 in Camalote, Cayo District

Of the 4 family members of gang members that were killed they were all killed in the following locations:

1 was shot in Dangriga
 1 was shot in Fabers Road area of Southside Belize City
 2 were shot on Cedar Street area of Southside Belize City

Who did the killing?

News reports are a bit scarce on this so this particular portion of the data may need to be updated by BCO and police. The data indicates the ages of those who were detained for the murders. It does not detail whether or not they were charged or convicted

19 of the murders had no known assailant at the time of this publication

1 of the alleged assailants was 17

1 of the alleged assailants was 19

7 alleged assailants were between the ages of 20 to 25

9 of the alleged assailants were between ages of 26 to 30

3 of the alleged assailants were between 31 and 40

1 of the alleged assailants was a domestic partner (beating)

1 of the alleged assailants was a brother in law

1 of the alleged assailants knew the victims name

1 of the alleged assailants was a son of the victim

1 of the alleged assailants was a male of spanish decent

1 of the alleged assailants was the step daughters boyfriend

1 of the alleged assailants met the victim under the pretense of needing mechanical help

17 of the 34 people executed by gunshot had alleged assailants detained. All alleged assailants appear to be Creole and are between the ages of 17 and 31

13 men were detained for 25 gang related murders in which 16 known gang members were killed.

3 of the alleged assailants of the 7 victims who were stabbed were detained. All of those were known to the victims. The assailants were of spanish or mayan decent with the exception of one who was Garifuna

3 of the alleged assailants of the 6 victims who were chopped were detained. All of those were known to the victims. The assailants were of spanish or mayan decent






Breakdown of Victims by Age






